"Donsar" Syrah

Red ruby, with hints of garnet. Intense bouquet with notes of spices, balsamic and cherry jam. Delicate and elegant on the palate and persistent on the finish.

Appellation	Terre Siciliane IGT
Vineyard	Vineyards at 100 meters above sea level in Contrada Donza d'Oro in the Comune of Marsala. East/West exposure with sunlight all day. Loamy-clay soil. Average age of vines are 20 years.
Vinification	The grapes are carefully selected and hand picked at harvest during the cooler hours of the day. After de-stemming, maceration takes place at a controlled temperature, followed by alcoholic fermentation (18/25 days), before racking. The wine refines in stainless steel and 3 months in large oak cherry barrels before bottling.
Pairing	It pairs well with red meat, game and flavorful first courses.
Serving	Serve at 60-65°F.

The passion and love of the land has been passed down from "Don Pino" to his children and grandchildren, where all three generations collaborate in a marriage of tradition and modernity in the recently restored winery in Marsala, on Sicily's western coast. The grapes are harvested manually to avoid oxidation and are treated with the best viticulture techniques in order to maximize the qualities of each wine. The connection to the land is reiterated by the choice of having monovarietal wines of native Sicilian varieties. As the winemaker Laudicina says: "the company's goal is to transfer the uniqueness of Sicily to Baglio Oro wines."
