This Beaujolais-Villages offers a beautiful garnet red color with light shiny reflections. It gives off elegant aromas of red fruits and wild flowers. The palate is perfectly balanced with the supple and fruity attack preceding a fleshy, gourmet texture. The finish is powerfully aromatic, with a beautiful freshness.

Vineyard

Granite and sandy soils on the surface on a sandstone subsoil. Age of the vines are 35-50 years, depending on the plots.

Vinification

Hand-harvested followed by whole cluster fermentation using indigenous yeasts. Carbonic maceration for 7 to 8 days. Aged in stainless steel and cement vats, diatomaceous filtering without fining.



The Tracot estate has been rooted in Beaujolais for over eighty years and four generations. Today, Jean-Paul Dubost runs the 29-hectare estate in Lantignié and several small parcels in five of the Beaujolais Cru villages. Passionate about his terroir, he offers a range of wines that reflect all the nuances of Beaujolais.
