# Brouilly Vieilles Vignes

This “old vines” vintage is among the great Brouillys. An intense red color with purple highlights and powerful aromas of red fruits illustrate the wine. The palate is racy, with a very good texture and reveals a pleasant mineral note that precedes a very aromatic and fruity finish.

Soils consist of clay-limestone with blue schist in the subsoil. Age of vines are 45-55 years.

Vinification

Late manual harvest with over-ripe small berries. Whole bunches. Carbonic maceration over 10 to 12 days without crushing. First pressing 1 month after malolactic fermentation. Maturing in concrete vats. Light filtration and low sulfite additions.



The Tracot estate has been rooted in Beaujolais for over eighty years and four generations. Today, Jean-Paul Dubost runs the 29-hectare estate in Lantignié and several small parcels in five of the Beaujolais Cru villages.
