A fresh, clean wine with prominent acidity. Light yellow with greenish shades. On the palate, citric notes like lime stand out, as well as green apple. It has great varietal character and medium structure.

Appellation	Mendoza
Vineyard	This wine comes from a blend of vineyards in Uco Valley and Luján de Cuyo in Mendoza.
Vinification	A process of controlled harvest is conducted, aimed at preventing oxidation and loss of quality prior to fermentation. Traditional fermentation is achieved in stainless steel tanks at low temperatures for approximately 24 days. Aging is carried out in steel tanks prior to bottling.
Pairing	Pair with seafood, white fish, pasta with herbs and vegetable salads.

Familia Millán is a family winery founded by José Jesús Millán in Mendoza, Argentina, over fifty years ago with vineyards originating in 1922. José Junior runs the estate now, in the land where he was raised, surrounded by the beautiful landscape of Mendoza with the Andes mountains, vineyards and of course the world renown Malbec. Abrasado is a play on words that combines "asado", meaning both to grill meat and also to spend time with friends, with "abrazado" which means to embrace. Thus, the Abrasado wines are meant to bring together cherished friends with a fabulous meal.
