Chateau la Guillaumette Bordeaux Superieur "Tradition"

This Bordeaux is clear, bright ruby red with cherry highlights. Aromas are expressed with notes of red currants and black cherries. The attack is direct, accompanied by notes of red fruit. The finish is full with fine tannins.

Merlot 80% Cabernet Sauvignon 20%

Organic

Appellation	Bordeaux Superieur AOC
Vineyard	Seven hectares of organic vineyards consisting of clay and limestone soils and vines with a minimum age of thirty years.
Vinification	Maceration in stainless still vats with cap punching during the fermentation of indigenous yeasts. Maturing in steel tanks for eight months before release.
Pairing	A versatile wine which pairs with burgers, rack of lamb or duck confit.



The Artigue family have been winemakers in the Bordeaux region, from father to son, for four generations. Chateau La Guillaumette, a beautiful 70 acre vineyard situated in Entre-deux-Mers is dedicated to Bordeaux Supérieur, while Chateau Galeteau, is a small St-Emilion Grand Cru vineyard, with an area of just under ten acres, located on the clay-limestone soils. Dedicated to organic practices, both properties are managed today by Bernard Artigue and his sons Antoine and Alexandre.
