Beautiful light ruby-purple color with red fruit aromas and distinctive pepper spice notes. Elegant and smooth, the wine exhibits classic Loire Valley red wine characteristics.

Appellation	Cheverny
Vineyard	Planted on siliceous clay and limestone soil, Domaine Le Portail consists of 32 hectares of vineyards. Vines are cultivated and vinified the traditional way to preserve their authenticity and promote the terroir. Certified sustainable by Terra Vitis.
Vinification	Thermo-regulated vinification in stainless steel with vatting time of ten days.
Pairing	Pairs with appetizers, BBQ, meats, cheese and is light enough for grilled fish.

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Located less than half a mile from the famous Château de Cheverny, Domaine Le Portail, once a monastery, is now a family-owned wine estate, run by Delphine and Damien Cadoux. Planted on siliceous clay soil, Domaine Le Portail consists of 32 hectares of vineyards, two of which grow the rare and ancient Romarantin grape in the Cour-Cheverny Appellation. The vines are cultivated and vinified the traditional way to preserve their authenticity and promote the terroir, producing aromatic and refined wines. Since 2000, the vineyards have adopted viticulture and wine production practices respectful of the environment and in compliance with the French sustainability organization Terra Vitis.
