Appellation	Minervois
Vineyards	The vineyard stretches over 35 hectares, of which 21 are AOC Minervois classified. The soil structure is diverse, comprising rolled pebbles, sandstone and limestone. On the stony soils where water is in short supply, the rocks are first crushed before the vine can be planted. The climate is characteristic of the Mediterranean, very dry and benefiting from exceptional sunshine.
Vinification	Traditional methods. 12 months elevage in cement tanks.
Pairing	Pairs beautifully with grilled meats and barbecue, burgers, stews, and try it with gazpacho and other spiced or tangy dishes.
